1005 Tuscany Coupe Dinner Plate

FS-2305 Blue Heaven

FS-2308 In The Pink

FS-2314 Black Lab

FS-2375 Jumpin' Jelly

FS-2381 Beboppin' Blue

NTG-9554 Snow Storm

6674 Round #4 Brush

6322 Fun Writer (3 pk) – 2 sets

Sponge

Sgraffito Tool

Tissue Paper

Water-based fine-tip marker

Pencil



Directions

Step 1: Trace the outside of the Dragonfly pattern on to the plate.

Step 2: Apply 3 coats of Snowstorm to the Dragonfly body and wings. Do not apply heavy coats or it will take too long to dry.

Step 3: Water down Blue Heaven, In The Pink and Jumpin' Jelly.

Step 4: Using a #4 brush apply Blue Heaven to the top area of all 4 wings. Next apply In The Pink below Blue Heaven, blending them in to each other. Do the same with Jumpin' Jelly, blending it below In The Pink. It should look like a water color effect.

Step 5: Apply 2 solid coats of Beboppin' Blue to the Dragonfly head and body.

Step 6: Using the #4 brush, apply 1 coat of Black Lab over the Beboppin' Blue on the head and body. Wet the brush, then dab off on a paper towel, then pull some of the Black Lab from the eyes and left side of the body to. When completely dry, use a sgraffito tool to make scratches in those areas.

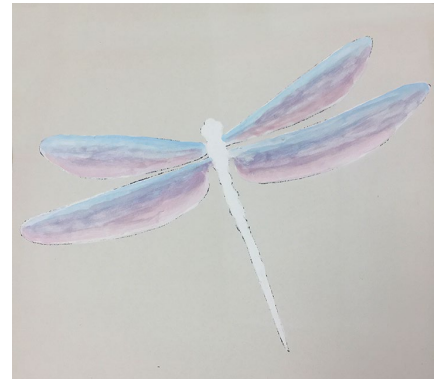
Step 7: Using a Fun Writer filled with Black Lab, outline the body, wings and to add details. See pattern on next page for wings.

Step 8: Using a sponge with Black Lab, swipe a band around the rim of the plate.

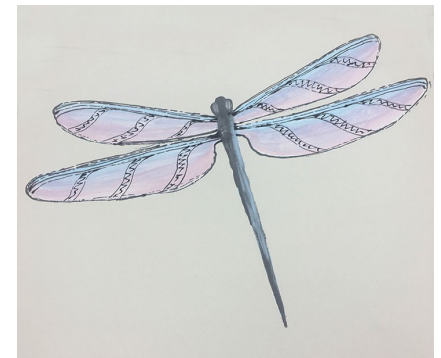
Optional: Use a stamp or screen print to add a quote on the plate if desired.

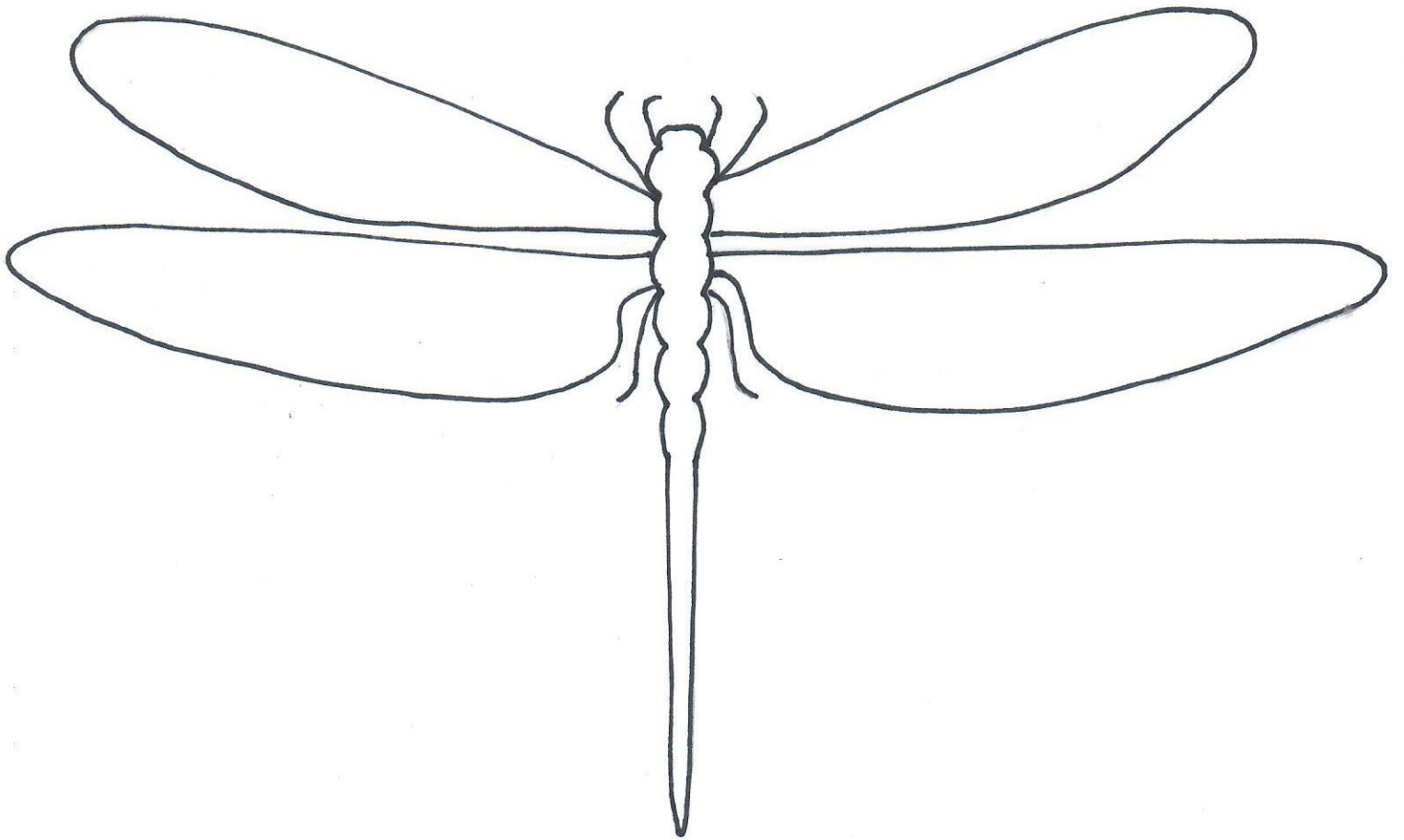
Step 9: Dip in clear glaze. Fire to cone 06.

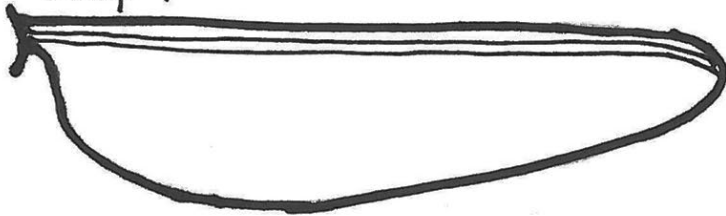

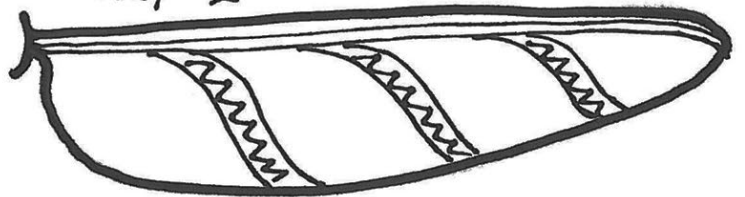


DragonFly Wings

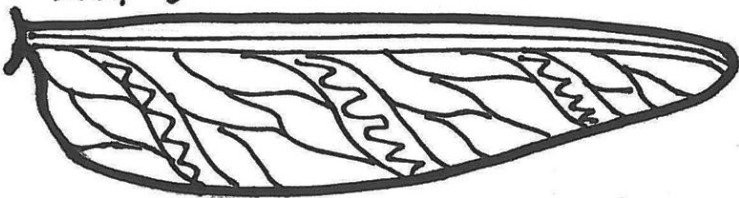
